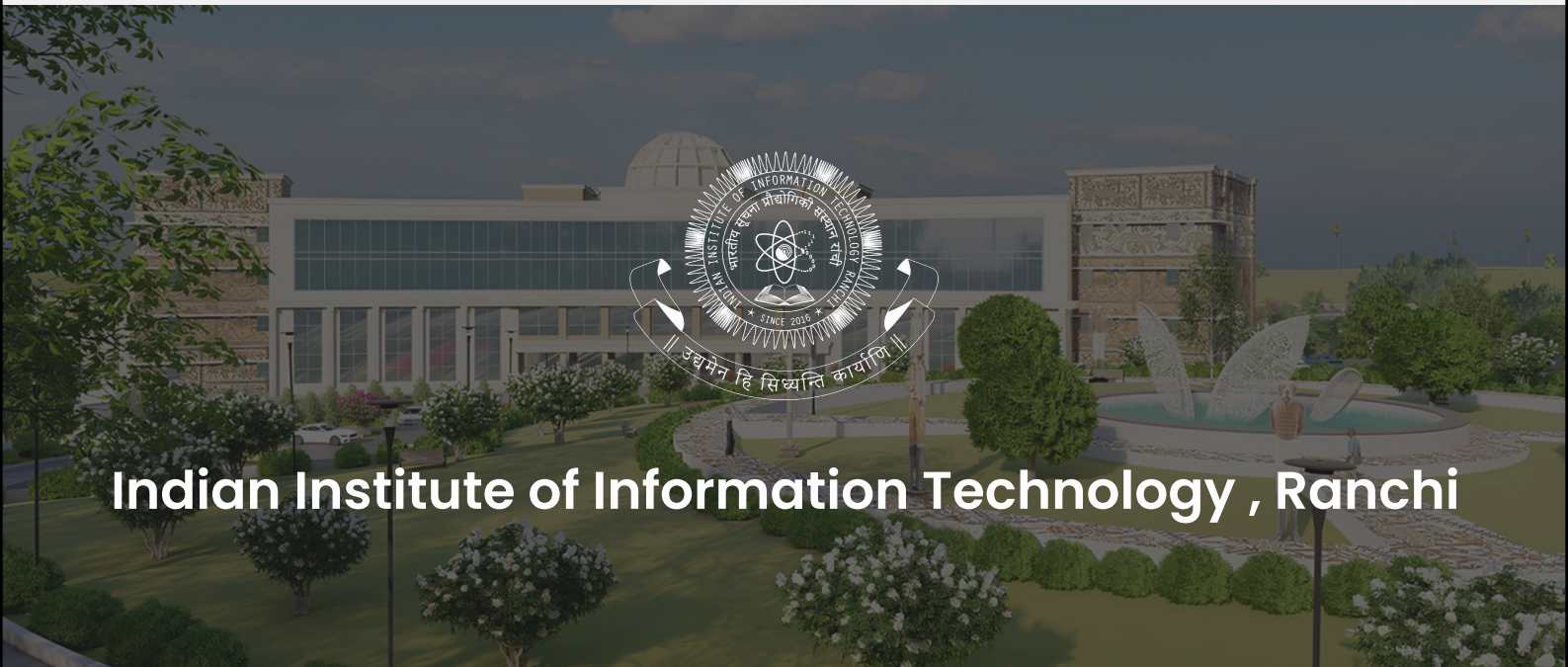




Indian Institute of Information Technology , Ranchi

About the Institute

1. Indian Institute of Information Technology Ranchi, India is an autonomous institute set up by the MoE, Government of India, and Government of Jharkhand with the industry Tata Motors, TCS and CCL on a Public Private Partnership (PPP) in the year 2016. MoE, Government of India has taken up the initiative to set up 20 new Indian Institutes of Information Technology (IIITs) on a Public Private Partnership Model. A major objective in establishing IIITs is to set up a model of education which can produce best-in-class human resources in IT and harness the multi-dimensional facets of information technology in various domains.
2. The permanent campus of IIIT Ranchi is being developed at Sanga Village, Kanke, Ranchi, with major progress across several facilities. Structural work for the main gate, boundary wall, boys' hostel, and staff residences is largely complete, while the academic and administrative buildings are at advanced stages of construction. Finishing work is underway for completed structures, including hostels and residential quarters. Once finished, the campus will offer modern academic infrastructure, research facilities, student hostels, and recreational spaces. Construction work is currently on hold.
3. The Indian Institute of Information Technology Ranchi organized Celestio 3.0, a techno-cultural fest featuring technical competitions and cultural events. Highlights included an ICPC-style Programming Contest, GenXcelerate AI Challenge, Brand Quest, CP Rumble, along with music, dance, theatre, fashion, and performances by Sunidhi Chauhan, Ripples Band, and Mirrorz Band, showcasing IIIT Ranchi's spirit of innovation, creativity, holistic student development, collaboration, leadership, excellence in technology and cultural expression, while fostering teamwork, learning, and meaningful engagement among participants from diverse backgrounds.

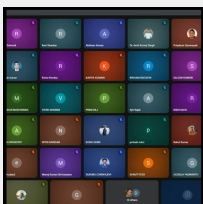
C-DAC Patna Delegation Visit

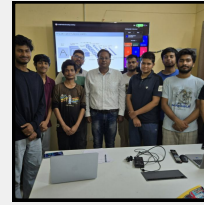
Central Library Hosts IRINS Session

Placement

Placement Statistics 2026

The 2022-26 placement season witnessed another strong performance by IIIT Ranchi students, with 243 offers secured and an average CTC of ₹16.16 LPA, the highest average package achieved by the institute to date. The highest package stood at ₹60 LPA, while the median package was ₹12 LPA. A total of 170 students have been placed so far, with the B.Tech CSE (DS & AI) program recording 100% placement. Students received offers from leading organizations including Amazon, DE Shaw, NVIDIA, Swiggy, Rubrik, Walmart, Cisco, IBM, Razorpay, Zomato, Infosys, Cognizant, TCS, and many others, reflecting the institute's growing industry presence and academic excellence. The statistics are provisional and subject to change as the placement process continues.
